

Brief History of Our School

The idea of establishing a branch for St. Aloysius' Senior Secondary School Jabalpur was originated from the growing demand by the people, for quality education from St. Aloysius' School. The land was purchased at Polipathar on 29th November 2000. Fr. George P.A. and Fr. Mathew Joseph were appointed to develop the place on 10th April 2001. The planning began for the establishment of a school at Polipathar and the first admissions were taken in Feb. 2002 in L.K.G., U.K.G. and Class I numbering almost 180 boys and girls.

St. Aloysius' School, Polipathar was founded on 2nd July 2002. The inaugural function was held by the St. Aloysius Sr. Secondary School at Sadar, Jabalpur. Rt. Rev. Gerald Almeida, Bishop of Jabalpur blessed the granite plate with the inscription that St. Aloysius' School, Polipathar, Jabalpur was founded on 2nd July 2002 during the tenure of Fr. George P.A. as Principal, in the presence of many Fathers, Sisters, teachers, parents, students and well-wishers.

The construction work of this school was taken up in the month of March 2002. Due to delay in the construction, the school was functioning from St. Aloysius' Sr. Secondary School campus at Sadar. On 2nd December 2002 the school was shifted to the present campus at Polipathar with 180 students, 5 teachers and 3 office staff on the rolls.

St. Aloysius School, Polipathar is a minority institution managed by the Catholic Diocese of Jabalpur and administered by the Jabalpur Diocesan Educational Society: a registered body. It is an English medium school for boys and girls with CBSE syllabus up to Senior Secondary level and provide excellent and quality based education to all section of people. The school is dedicated to St. Aloysius with its motto '*Virtus in Arduo*' (Excellence through hardship).

St. Aloysius is the patron and model for youth. His cherished dream was to follow Jesus Christ and serve his fellowmen. Though he lived in this world for only 23 years, St. Aloysius left an admirable example of obedience and love for everyone to follow. So all Aloysians are constantly reminded of their responsibility to follow their patron saint and form their character by tackling the tough things in life.

A meeting of the Governing Body of the Jabalpur Diocesan Educational Society was held on 12th December 2002 and has resolved to upgrade the school and seek the CBSE recognition from Delhi. Meanwhile the school campus is being developed with a beautiful building, modern facilities like Computer Lab, Library, Auditorium, Amphi-theatre, Football, Basketball, Handball, Badminton, Volleyball courts and Swimming Pool to make sure of the all-round development of the students enrolled in this institution.

In the year 2010 the school was upgraded upto Senior Secondary level by CBSE with Science and Commerce streams.
